



A Joint EURADH and FEICA Award for Innovative Adhesion Science



Call for applications

FEICA, the association representing the European adhesive and sealant industry, and EURADH, the biannual European conference on adhesion and related phenomena, are delighted to announce the inauguration of a new joint award for adhesion science. The Award for Innovative Adhesion Science aims to stimulate the interactions between industrial and scientific activities in adhesion science. The award will be funded by FEICA and presented at the EURADH conferences.

The award winner will have the opportunity to present their work at EURADH, which will take place in Antibes, France, 14-17 September 2020, and at the annual FEICA Conference and EXPO, which will take place in Warsaw, Poland, 9-11 September 2020. A prize of €3,000 and a certificate will be awarded to the winner at EURADH and at FEICA respectively. In addition, the participation fee for the two conferences will be waived and travel costs for the winner and, if applicable, his or her supervisor, will be refunded (flight bookings after agreement with FEICA; the total amount of the extra expenses are not to exceed € 2,000).

Applications are invited from young researchers working in adhesion science in Europe who have published outstanding work. This includes masters students, doctoral students, post-docs, junior professors and researchers associated with universities, research institutes or companies. The scope and possible topics are identical to those of the call for papers for EURADH 2020.

The applicant must submit

- 1) A one-page text covering
 1. Summary of the work and results,
 2. Scientific impact in the specific field / in adhesion science,
 3. Relevance of the work, highlighting benefits to the circular economy, society, economy, sustainability, environment and/or industry.

Each of these three points should take about 1/3 of the page.

- 2) One publication (a file of the published manuscript, or if the paper has been accepted but not yet published – the letter of acceptance) covering the work in a peer reviewed international journal which has at least been accepted for publication, but which is not more than two years old, with the applicant as first or corresponding author. For publications with multiple authors, this must be accompanied by a declaration of the applicant's contribution.

- 3) Short CV (1 page maximum).
- 4) Letter of recommendation.

The application should be addressed to the chair of EURADH 2020 (valerie.nassiet@enit.fr), using the submission form available at <http://www.adhesionaward.org/submission/> not later than 20 March 2020.

You are recommended not to submit more than one application per company, or work group, / department of a university or institute. Contributions to EURADH should be submitted separately and submissions on the same topic are favoured.
